

Privacy Policy

This privacy policy sets out how Barham Motorcycle Club (BMCC) uses and protects any information that you give BMCC when you use this website.

BMCC is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified when using this website, then you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement.

BMCC may change this policy from time to time by updating this page. You should check this page from time to time to ensure that you are happy with any changes. This policy is effective from 25th April 2018.

What we collect

We may collect the following information:

- Name and date of birth/age;
- Contact information including email address;
- Demographic information such as postcode, preferences and interests;
- Other information regarding motorcycle ridden, class, etc.

What we do with the information we gather

We require this information to understand your needs and provide you with a better service, and in particular for the following reasons:

- Internal record keeping;
- We may periodically send promotional emails about new events, requests for assistance or other information, which we think you may find interesting using the email address that you have provided.
- Information details regarding entries and results may be shared with other parties involved in the organisation and running of our motorcycle events. For example the ACU.

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. In order to prevent unauthorised access, all records are held securely on password protected computers and encrypted drives. BMCC do not hold any personal information on internet storage platforms.

How we use cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive. Once you agree, the file is added, and the cookie helps analyse web traffic or lets you know when you visit a particular site. Cookies allow web applications to respond to you as an individual. The web application can tailor its operations to your needs, likes and dislikes by gathering and remembering information about your preferences.

We use traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We only use this information for statistical analysis purposes and then the data is removed from the system.

Overall, cookies help us provide you with a better website, by enabling us to monitor which pages you find useful and which you do not. A cookie in no way gives us access to your computer or any information about you, other than the data you choose to share with us.

You can choose to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. This may prevent you from taking full advantage of the website.

Visitors to our websites

When someone visits barhammotorcycleclub.co.uk we use a third party service, statcounter, to collect standard internet log information and details of visitor behaviour patterns. We do this to find out things such as the number of visitors to the various parts of the site. This information is only processed in a way, which does not identify anyone. We do not make, or allow Statcounter to make any attempt to find out the identities of those visiting our website.

Links to other websites

Our website may contain links to other websites of interest. However, once you have used these links to leave our site, you should note that we do not have any control over that other website. Therefore, we cannot be responsible for the protection and privacy of any information which you provide whilst visiting such sites and such sites are not governed by this privacy statement. You should exercise caution and look at the privacy statement applicable to the website in question.

Controlling your personal information

The collection or use of your personal information can be restricted in the following ways:

- Whenever you are asked to fill in a form on the website, look for the box that indicates you do not want the information to be used by anybody for direct marketing purposes and make sure it is unchecked;

Statcounter
